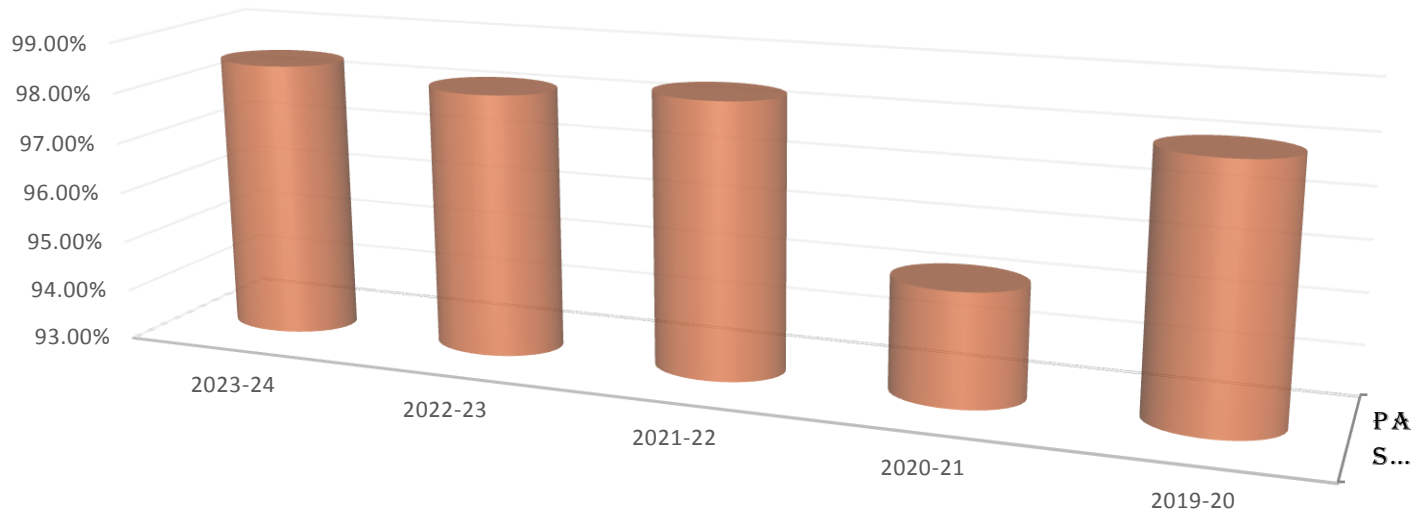

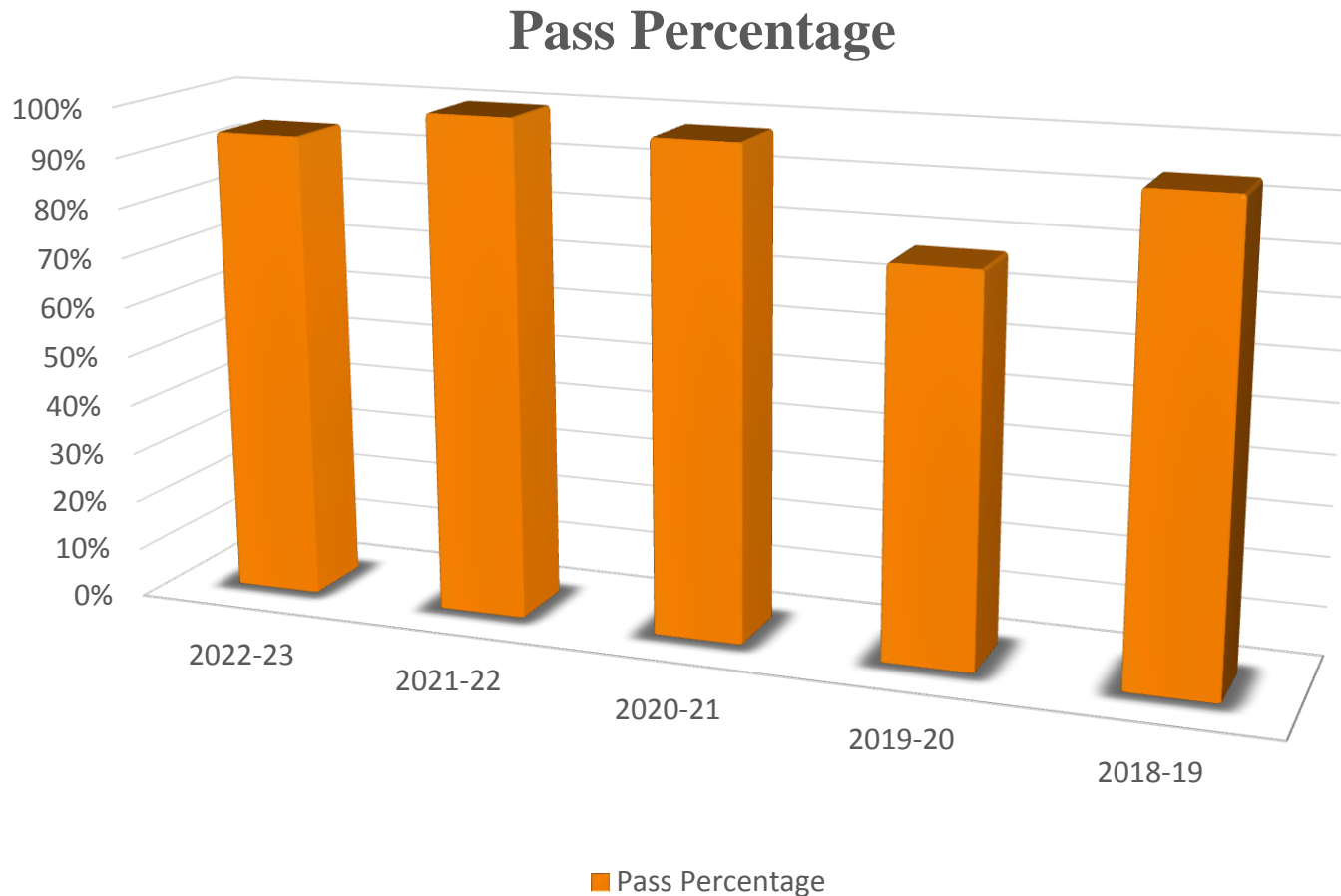

P.G Pass Percentage Session - 2018-19 to till date

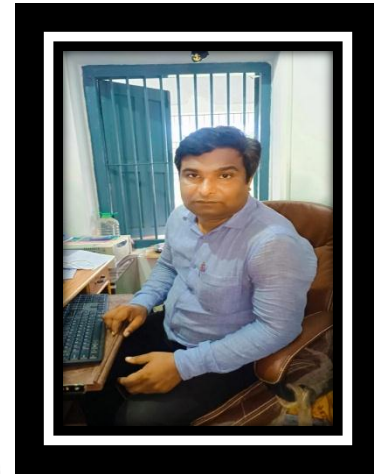
