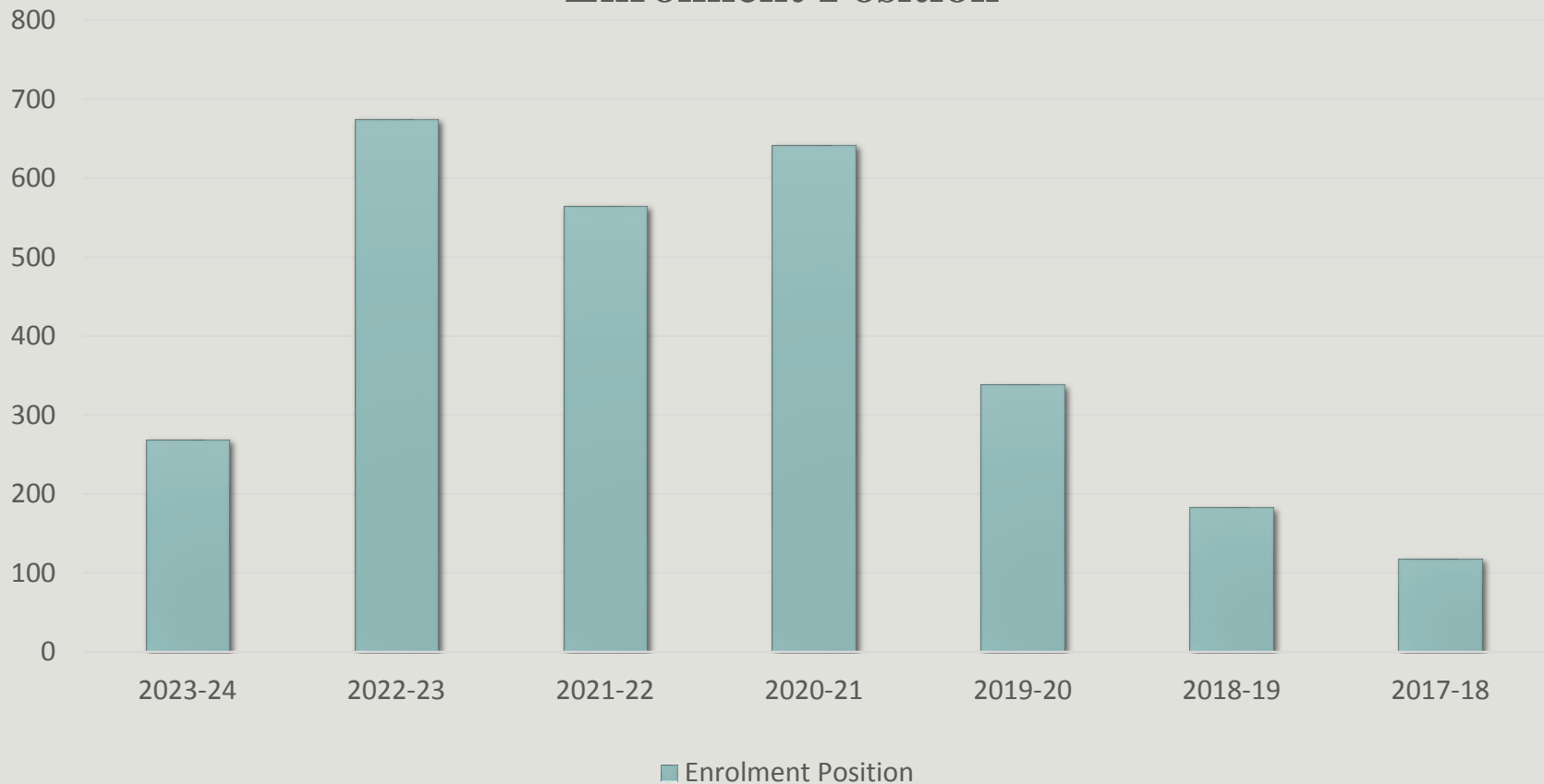

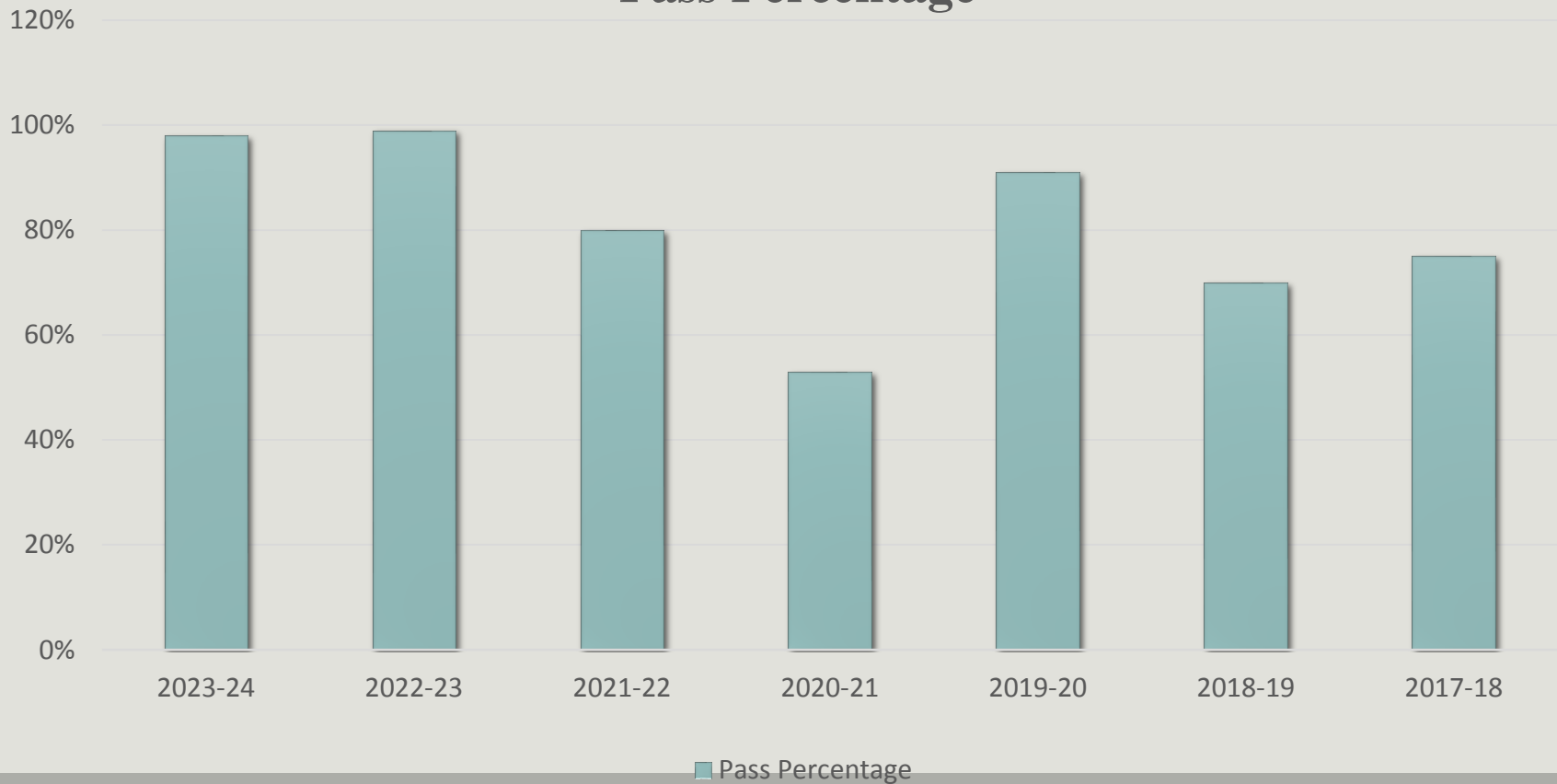

Pass Percentage





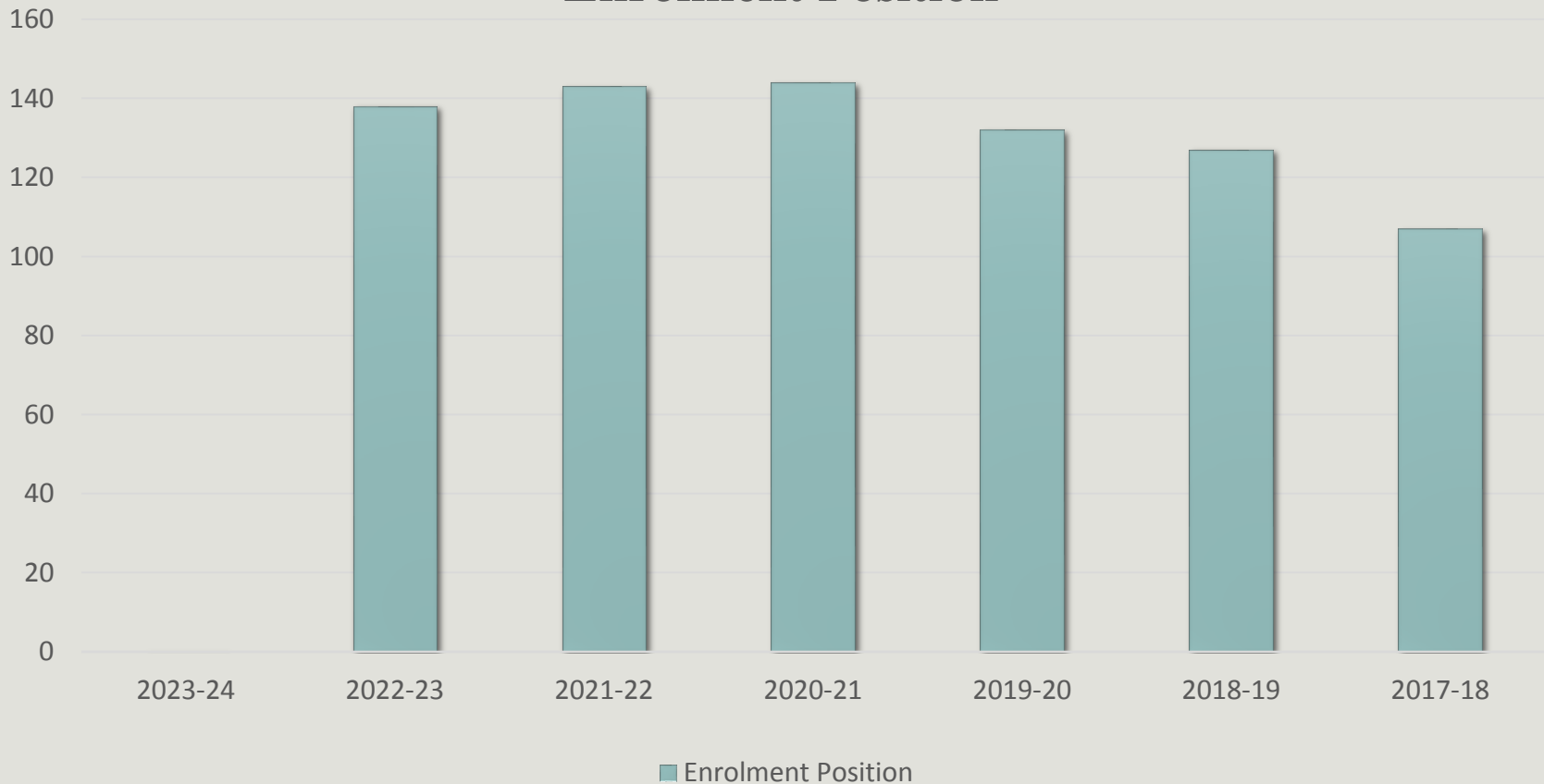

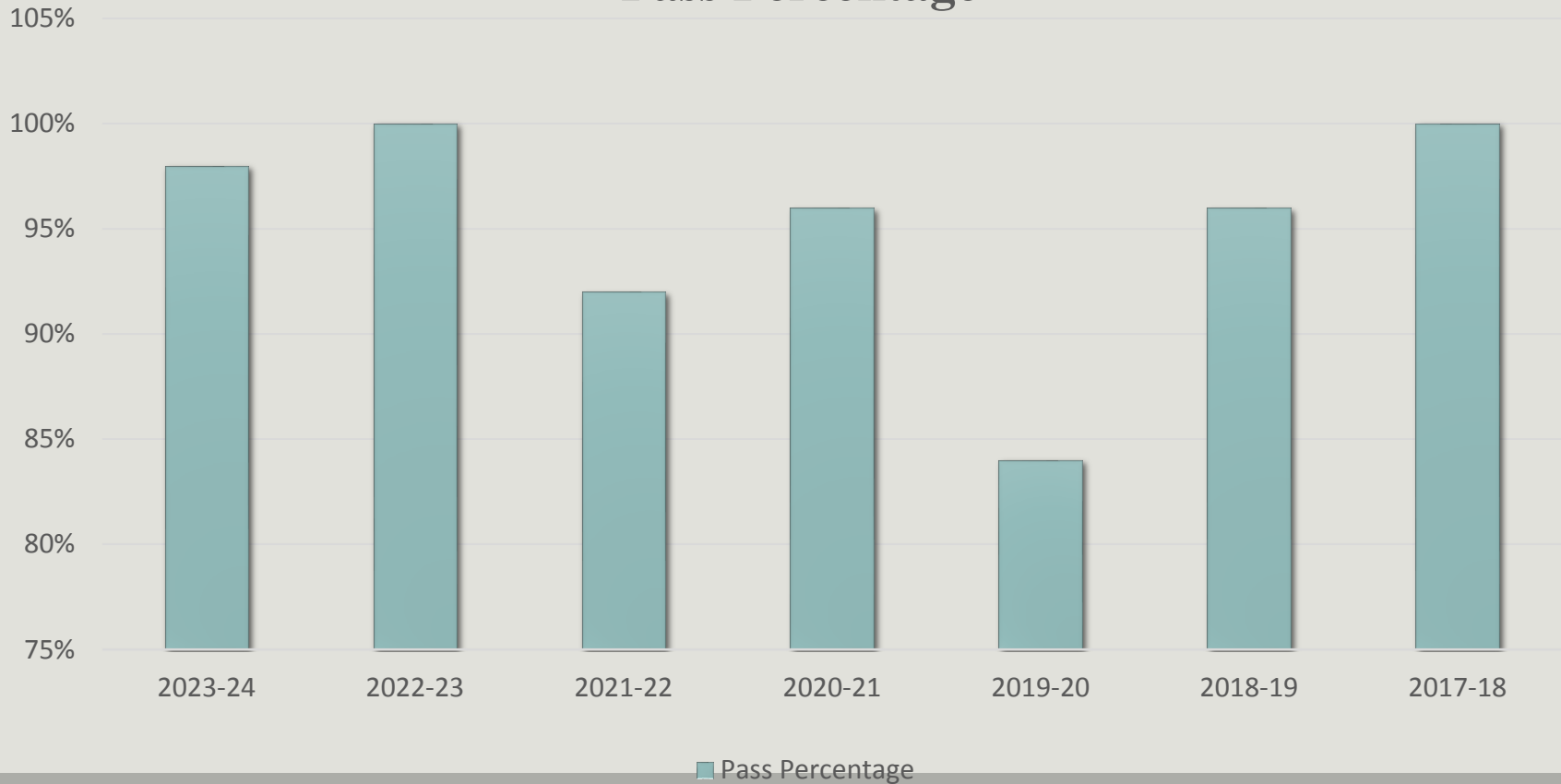
