## Enrolment Position in U.G Programme Session - 2017-18 to 2023-24



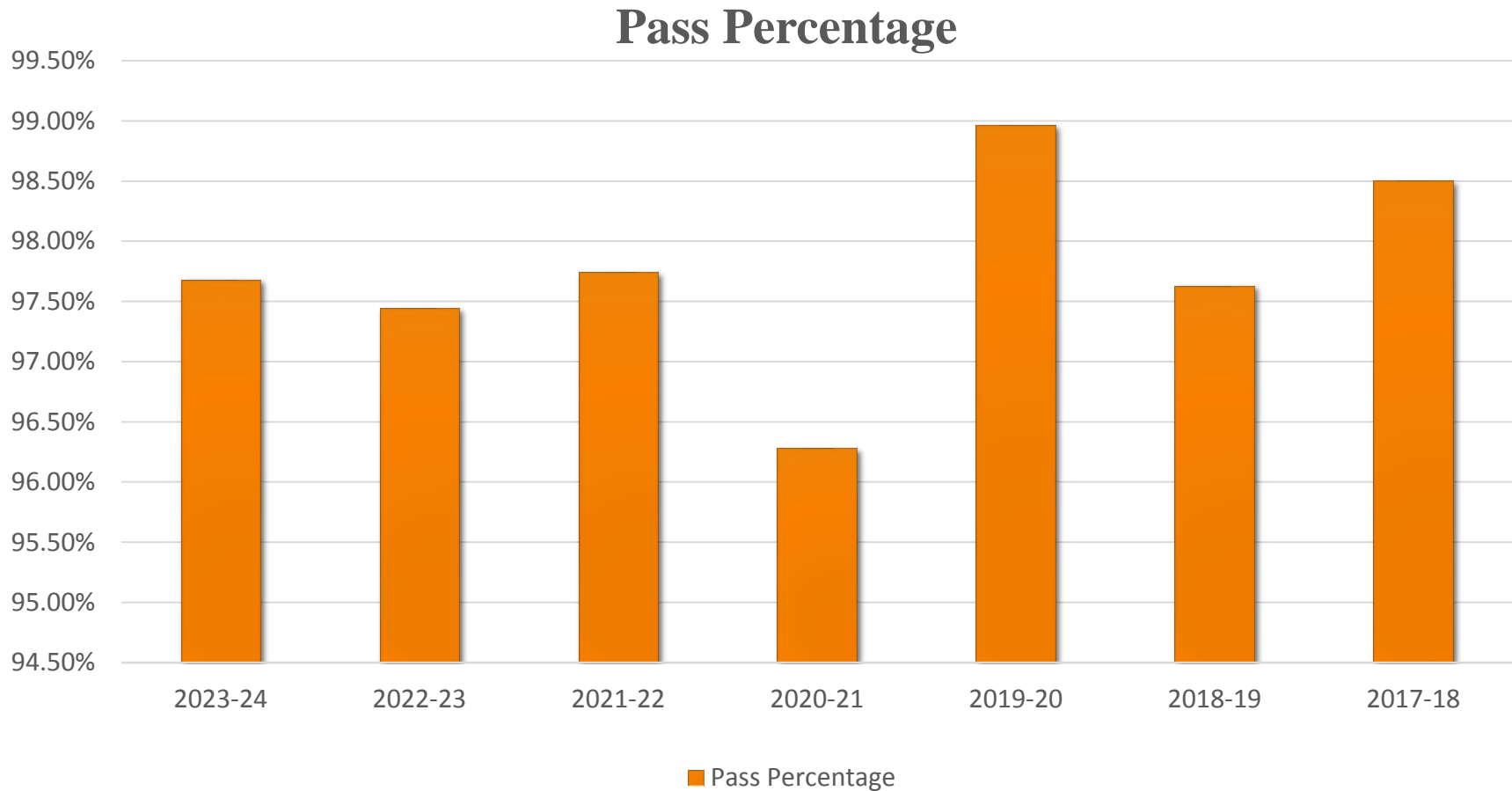

# U.G Pass Percentage Session - 2017-18 to 2023-24



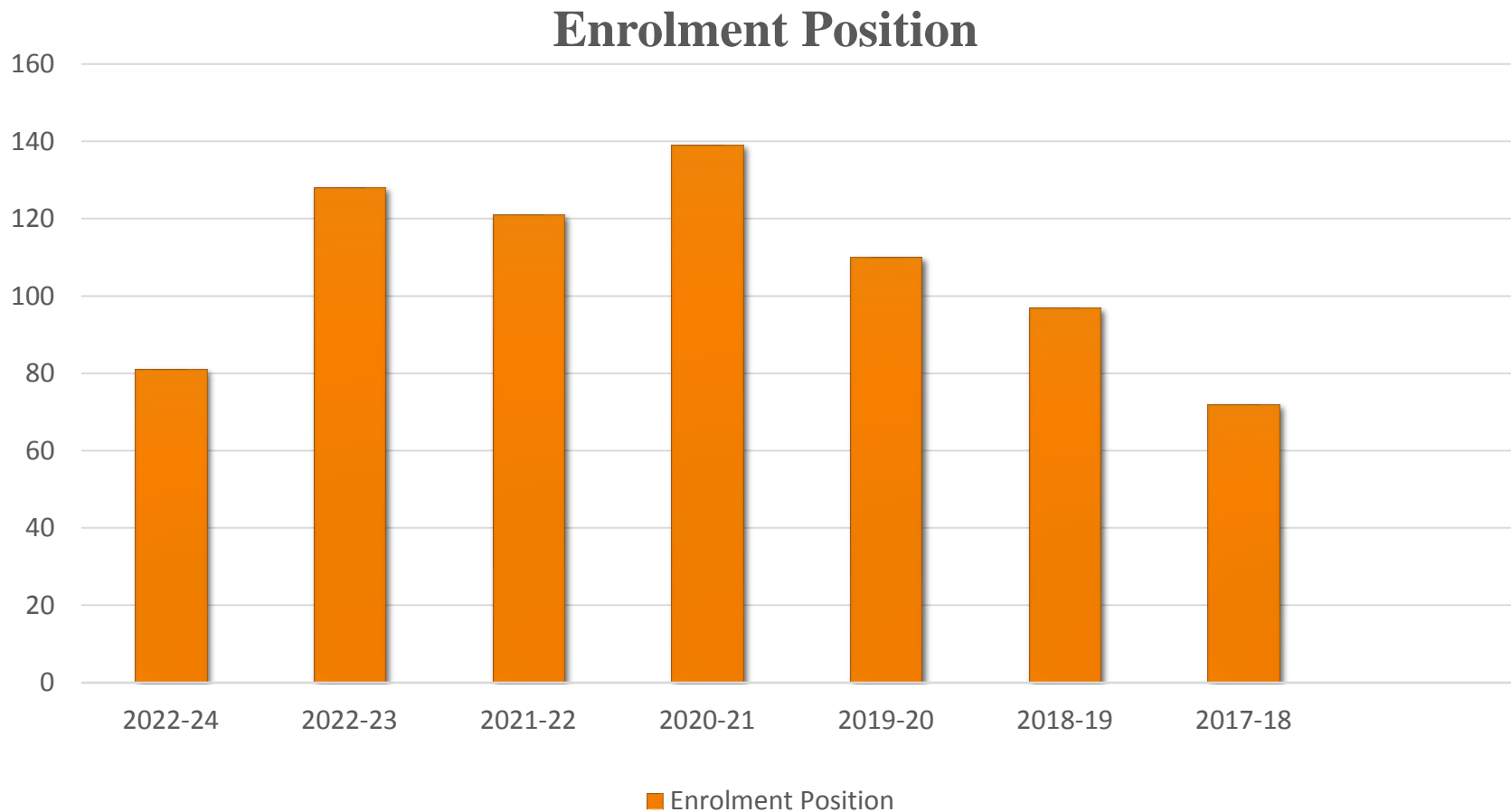

## Enrolment Position in P.G Programme Session - 2017-18 to 2023-24





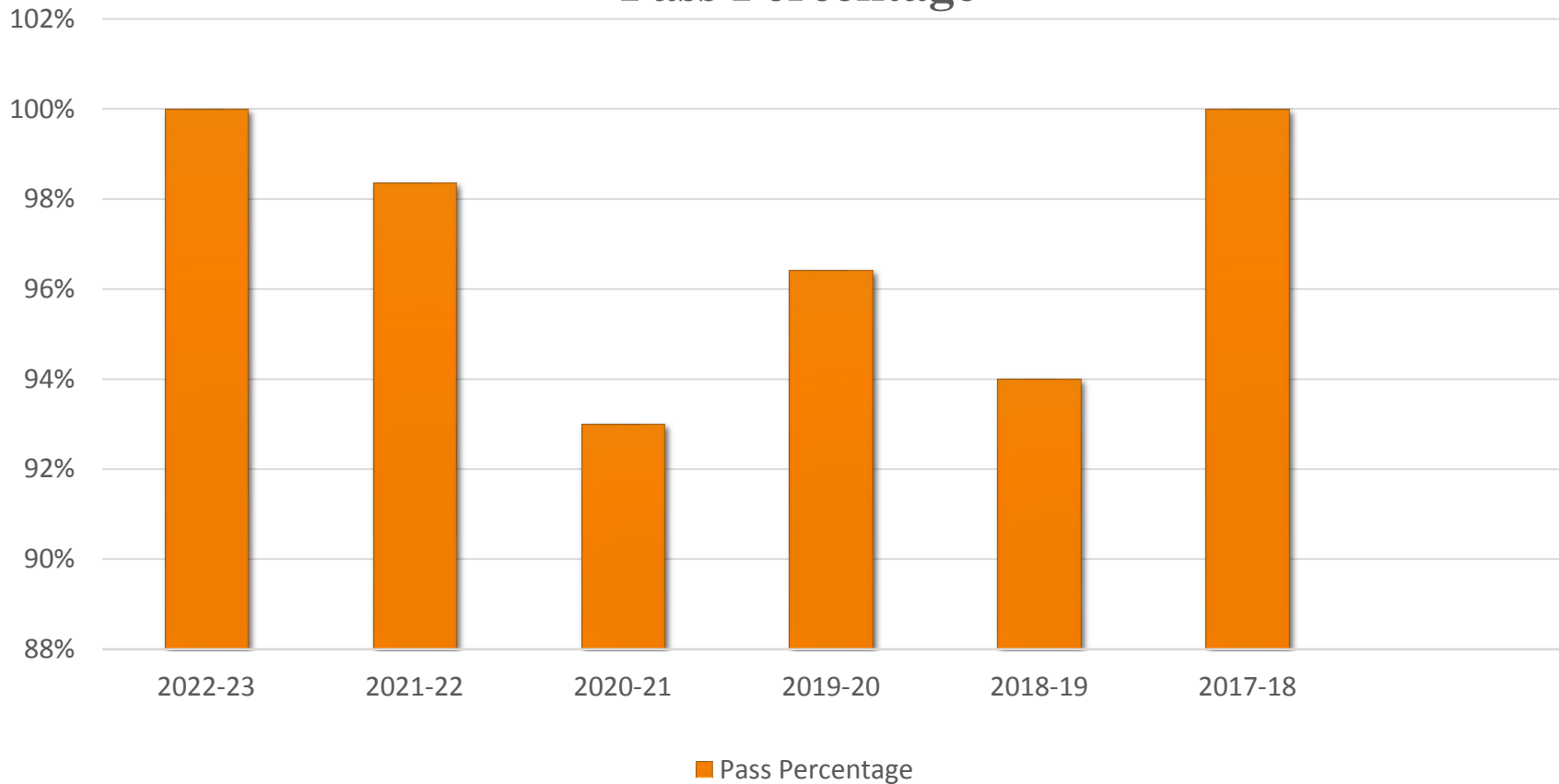
